

Ant Bank (Macao) Mobile App Launches English-Language Services

Macao, September 29, 2026 — Ant Bank (Macao) today announced the launch of English-language services on the Ant Bank mobile app. Starting immediately, Macao residents will be able to choose from and switch between the app's Chinese and English versions with a single tap. This means that customers can now open an account in as little as one minute and access everyday banking services such as deposits, remittances, and the trading of Hong Kong and US stocks entirely in English.



This upgrade synchronizes the app's English and Chinese functionalities, with the English version now providing access to Ant Bank (Macao)'s full suite of digital banking products and services. The bank offers HKD, MOP, and USD demand deposits with interest accrued daily, featuring rates of up to 2% for HKD and MOP, and up to 3% for USD. Customers can

also open a time deposit with just MOP 100 and enjoy flexible terms, with no penalty for early withdrawal. Deposits are protected under the Deposit Protection Scheme, covering up to MOP 800,000.

Ant Bank (Macao) also offers Hong Kong and US stock trading, odd-lot trading for Hong Kong stocks, customizable conditional orders, US stock options, and pre-market and after-hours trading. These features give customers greater flexibility in managing their investment portfolios.

As Macao's first digital bank to offer fully online banking services, Ant Bank (Macao) is committed to simplifying finance, introducing a number of innovative digital banking services in the region with this very aim. This includes eKYC (electronic Know Your Customer), digital loans, and same-day cross-border transfers between Macao and the Chinese mainland. Its mobile app also offers online account opening and a range of banking services, letting customers flexibly manage their finances whenever it suits them best.

While digital banking remains at the core of its customer experience, Ant Bank (Macao) also offers physical access points for in-person or self-service needs. These include the bank's 24-hour self-service branch and the new Galaxy Macau and Ant Bank (Macao) Financial Services Station.
